Over the last years, we have also gone beyond the film with exhibits, art performances and book readings – in fact, all things science-fiction!

With our live festival experience, we have been offering a platform for Independent Sci-fi Filmmakers to present their work on the big screen and get in touch with a live audience in one of the most beautiful and world-famous cinemas in Berlin – The Babylon (where Metropolis was first screened in 1927). Sadly, due to the current COVID-19 situation and restrictions, the Babylon has closed for the time being and our live event postponed.

But, you can't keep a good Independent down! With the aim of keeping the festival alive and reach out to a global audience, we have partnered with [XERB.TV](#) to create a virtual theatre experience. Our Exclusive Virtual Cinema will run for the whole weekend from the 27th November to 6th December 2020. There are 110 feature and short films from 28 countries in all subgenres and styles – and many filmmakers are providing us with exclusive introductions to their films!
